### You said:

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) is becoming a concern to you.

### We did:

We have continued our efforts with an ongoing operation to tackle anti-social behaviour. Recently there has been a small group of youngsters knocking on doors and running off. The offenders for this have been identified and we will be holding meetings with parents and the anti-social behaviour co-ordinator at Staffordshire Moorlands District Council to continue tackling the issue of ASB. If anyone is suffering anti-social behaviour, please contact us with as much information as possible.

Inconsiderate parking is occurring around Cellarhead, near to Moorside High School, and in Washerwall Lane in Werrington.

**You said:**

Nuisance off-road motorbikes are causing concern to residents around Cheddleton.

**We did:**

Warnings have been issued to several riders of the bikes and one vehicle has been seized so far. The warnings last for twelve months and if that rider is seen riding another machine in an anti-social manner again, then the vehicle is seized immediately - whether it belongs to the rider or someone else. Also, if the same machine is being ridden by another person, the machine can still be seized.



**Thief's Christmas shop window?**

Police are urging people to keep themselves and their property safe this festive period. Take simple crime prevention measures to avoid presenting opportunist thieves with free gifts and other valuable items:

- if you can't keep your shopping with you, lock it your boot
- at home keep presents away from windows
- take cardboard/wrappings of large items to the tip to avoid advertising you have a new TV, bike or other new products
- keep your vehicles and homes locked at all times and keep keys away from windows and doors.
