We received your request on 28/05/2024 and have processed this under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Please be advised that the data has been provided from our Road Traffic Collision database, whereby the location has been listed as A527 between the junctions of Grange Road and Meadows



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Way. Likewise the data has been extracted where the most severe collision injury has been disclosed.

Please note that this data has been provided to the best of our ability, subject to the limitation of current recording protocols and systems/software.

Every effort is made to ensure that the data presented is accurate and complete. However, it is important to note that this has been extracted from multiple sources, developed for specific policing purposes, for which data extraction methods have not been specifically designed to directly correlate with the terminology of this request. Therefore, the data presented is subject to the inaccuracies and idiosyncrasies inherent in any large-scale recording system.

As a consequence, care should be taken in the interpretation and presentation of this data, so as to not misrepresent the whole or any part of the data disclosed.
