Request - You asked us the following:

- how many individuals are currently Released Under Investigation (RUI)
- how many individuals are currently on bail
- how many days each individual has been RUI
- what offence each RUI individual was arrested for, and any subsequent offences they may have been arrested for

We received your request on 09/10/2024 and have processed this under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Staffordshire Police's response to your enquiry is as follows:

In accordance with Section 17(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, this letter represents a refusal notice for this particular request.

The following exemptions have been applied:

- Section 12(1) where the cost of compliance exceeds the appropriate limit.
Section 12(1) does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the prescribed limit'.

The above information has been withheld for the following reasons:

There is no method by which we can readily retrieve information from our systems to answer this request. For the time period requested, there have been in excess of 1,300 individuals released under investigation. In order to determine the original offence each individual was arrested for, and for any subsequent offences the custody record for each individual would require manual review.

From dip sampling, it has been estimated that it would take approximately 5 minutes to review each record to answer this request, this would equate to over 108 hours. To achieve this task would therefore exceed the 18-hour time and cost threshold of the FOI Act by some considerable margin.

Advice and assistance

Section 16 of the Act places an obligation upon the Authority to provide advice and assistance, in order to comply with this obligation please see below.

If question 4 was withdrawn, Staffordshire Police would be able to provide data for the number of individuals currently released under investigation, the number of individuals currently on bail and for the number of individuals currently released under investigation, the number of days each individual has been released under investigation.
