Request - You asked us the following:

I am looking for information regarding driving offences per region, across the last four years.

I would like to receive the below information in excel format please:

- List of all driving offences committed that resulted in a fine, broken down per year 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 up to September 2024
- Amount of fines paid per driving offence, broken down per year 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 up to September 2024

We received your request on 09/10/2024 and have processed this under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Staffordshire Police's response to your enquiry is as follows:

Staffordshire Police holds/does not hold the requested information.

- List of all driving offences committed that resulted in a fine, broken down per year 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 up to September 2024 – **Disclosed, please see accompanying file titled 'FOI 17342 Driving Offences Data.CSV'.**
- Amount of fines paid per driving offence, broken down per year 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 up to September 2024 – **No information held.**

Please note that the data provided includes the disposal methods of 'paid', 'paid/licence endorsed' and 'prosecuted'. It is not possible to filter our searches specifically for fines.

Please note that this data has been provided to the best of our ability, subject to the limitation of current recording protocols and systems/software. Additional offences may have been recorded during these timescales but are awaiting finalisation and input onto these systems and would not be present within this dataset.

Every effort is made to ensure that the data presented is accurate and complete. However, it is important to note that this has been extracted from multiple sources, developed for specific policing purposes, for which data extraction methods have not been specifically designed to directly correlate with the terminology of this request. Therefore, the data presented is subject to the inaccuracies and idiosyncrasies inherent in any large-scale recording system.

As a consequence, care should be taken in the interpretation and presentation of this data, so as to not misrepresent the whole or any part of the data disclosed.
