3. December 2024 Modus Operandi

IP HAS BEEN IN THE PARK WITH FRIENDS AND LEFT THEM TO GO TO THE TOILET. OFFENDERS HAVE BEEN ON A MOTOR BIKE AND SHOWN WHAT THE IP BELIEVES TO HAVE BEEN A MACHETE TO HIM WHICH WAS DOWN THE TROUSERS OF ONE OF THE OFFENDERS.

IP REPORTING THEY ARE HAVING CONTINUED ISSUES WITH THEIR EX-PARTNER, WHO IS REFUSING TO RETURN THE VICTIM'S HOUSE KEYS AND THEY HAVE TAKEN PAYMENTS OUT IN THE VICTIM'S NAME. IP ALSO ADVISED THE SUSPECT WAS IN POSSESSION OF A MEAT CLEAVER, MACHETE AND A GUN WHEN THEY LEFT THE RELATIONSHIP.

SUSPECT HAS THREATENED THE IP WITH A MACHETE POINTING IT AT THE IP

THIS WAS INITIALLY REPORTED BY THE INFORMANT STATING THAT SHE AND HER FRIEND BOTH BEING CHASED BY SOMEONE AND POSSIBLY CARRYING A MACHETE THIS WAS NOT CONFIRMED. UPON OFFICERS ARRIVAL, THIS INCIDENT WAS DESCRIBED AS VERBAL ONLY ARGUMENT BETWEEN THE VICTIM AND A UNKNOWN CHILD IN THE STREET OVER AN ELECTRIC SCOOTER. ALTHOUGH INFORMANT REPORTED THAT A MACHETE HAD BEEN SEEN. VICTIM HAS CONFIRMED THAT SHE HAD NOT SEEN A MACHETE AT ANY POINT AND THAT SHE SIMPLY RAN AWAY DUE TO THE ARGUMENT.
