Imminent (July)

Business Burglary: Previous pattern during 2025 saw a series of incidents at [REDACTED] across Staffordshire and cross-border into West Mercia and West Midlands. A similar pattern is currently being seen targeting [REDACTED] across Staffordshire and further afield (Derbyshire, West Mercia, West Midlands, Leicestershire, Yorkshire and Greater Manchester). Alongside this there is a current trend of ATM Breaks [REDACTED] in focused around Derbyshire, West Mercia and West Midlands that might impact Staffordshire.

Less Serious Violence: Increase expected in July with the highest volume being Assault ABH with the top LPT during 2025 being Stoke South. The top NBH was [REDACTED] (Hanley Park and Shelton) with a repeat location of [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] identified.
