<b>Active Intelligence</b>	Active Intelligence is a system which can carry out a google like search of force legacy systems.
<b>ANPR (Back Office Facilities) KIV the admin owner is POLLY RICHARDSON)</b>	Manages information concerning Automatic Number Plate Recognition
<b>Asset Register Spreadsheet</b>	System used to monitor all fixed assets for the Force (including buildings, vehicles, IT and equipment which is over £10,000 or cumulatively over £500k)
<b>AXISe Pensions System</b>	Database for holding Police Pension records, and performing benefit calculations
<b>Centurion</b>	Complaint recording system recording complaints against police/police staff
<b>Citizen Focus Toolkit</b>	Platform for the development of community profiles and to support problem solving activity in local communities
<b>CLIO - Action Management, Crisis Management</b>	
<b>Clue2</b>	Anti Corruption Unit's intelligence and case management system.
<b>CMS2 (Crime Management System 2)</b>	Crime Recording system
<b>Cohort</b>	Appointment diary for making medical appointments, i.e. OHA/OHP, physio, welfare, counsellor, mandatory support, medicals
<b>Community Contact Database</b>	Register of key contacts, by Local Policing Team (LPT) and NMA
<b>Community Resolution database</b>	A diary system which front line officers use to arrange appointments for Youth Offending / Police Officers who will arrange for the young offender and his/her parents to attend a surgery appointment at which time the disposal outcome will be served for the criminal offence.
<b>Compact</b>	Database for Staffordshire missing persons for the recording and management of missing person investigations
<b>COPS (Covert Policing Operations System)</b>	Management of surveillance applications and authorisations
<b>Crimestoppers</b>	Phone calls, texts & e-mails received from Crimestoppers UK received into force and placed onto data base, evaluated and placed onto second data base and onto SPIN if appropriate. Information is then allocated to LPT or department best suited to deal. Updates recorded on this data base
<b>Custody CCTV requests</b>	CCTV within Custody
<b>Custody Watch</b>	The custody watch account was created after an audit and review inspection to monitor certificate holders who have come to police notice recently

<b>CyComms</b>	Management of applications and authorisations for accessing communications data and retention
<b>Eborders Semaphore System</b>	E borders is a UK Border Agency system to access information in support of a wide range of policing on travellers crossing the United Kingdom's Borders.
<b>E-CINS</b>	Case management system used for Integrated Offender Management (IOM), Restorative Justice and problem solving in LPT's. It is also used by external partners to case manage issues such as troubled families.
<b>Email</b>	Provides desktop email and messaging (SMS, Fax). Also provides access to Domino application workflow.
<b>Eros2</b>	The system supports the administration of fixed penalty notices
<b>Family Liaison Officers system</b>	Provides a central point for recording the deployments of Family Liaison Officers.
<b>Fig tree</b>	System used to monitor and record insurance claims either raised by or against Staffordshire police
<b>FMU (File Management Unit) system, also known as CJAD (Criminal Justice Administration Department)</b>	Crime Recording system, SPIN, Criminal Justice
<b>Freedom of Information (FOI) Request Management System</b>	To provide a central point for recording and tracking FOI requests
<b>Guardian</b>	Application to record and manage Vulnerable Persons
<b>HOLMES 2 Major Incident Enquiry System</b>	An investigation management system.
<b>i2 Analyst Workstation</b>	The i2 Analyst Workstation is a suite of tools (Analyst Notebook, DataMiner & XD Mapping) linked by a database (ibase). The system is designed so that elements of Force Legacy systems are downloaded on a daily basis so that searching can be undertaken and results displayed.
<b>I 24/7 INSYST Interpol Criminal Data Access Management System</b>	I/24/7 is a data base which police forces are allowed access to to combat international crime. It is owned by Interpol and holds information and flags on persons who are of interest to law enforcement. It is populated by Interpol from information and intelligence supplied from across the Globe
<b>IDENT1/Livescan</b>	National Automated Fingerprint Identification System. Comprises of National Fingerprint Collection and Unidentified Marks Database. Hard copies of scene of crime marks and fingerprint forms are also held.
<b>Innkeeper</b>	Force database listing all Licensed Premises in Staffordshire. This system outlines details of personal licence holders, Premises licences, visits to premises, incidents at Licensed premises and holds copies of all conditions imposed on said premises.
<b>Key Information Management System (KIM)</b>	Enables all crime files submitted through the Force Archive Unit to be tracked accordingly, system supports outsourcing to TNT & Time Based Disposal in accordance with Management of Police Information (MoPI)

<b>KYM Property</b>	A Forcewide database to manage all property items, lost, found and detained across the county.
<b>MID Enquiry Management System</b>	To provide a central point for recording current and archived Major investigation enquiries, updates and outcomes
<b>National Firearms Licensing System (NFLMS)</b>	The national database for all firearms certificate holders which facilitates the licensing process
<b>NSPIS Custody</b>	The application will help manage a detainee whilst in police custody. It will ensure that custody staff record detainee's personal and arrest details fully and correctly, ensuring that the legal requirements of the Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 (PACE) are met. The Custody application has an electronic link with the Police National Computer (PNC) allowing for automatic updating of the PNC with, for example, any information on future court appearances and bail details. The application interfaces with Case Preparation and allows for details to be transferred for completion of the MG File. Links to LiveScan and Video Witness
<b>NSPIS Case Prep</b>	The Case Preparation application improves the administration of cases, including efficient management of witness attendance and improved victim and witness care thus helping to meet the Government's objectives of a joined up criminal justice system. It also offers better exhibit management. Bureaucracy is reduced through the elimination of duplication of case files and re-keying information. In addition the information is shared electronically amongst all the criminal justice agencies, for example the Crown Prosecution Service and the Courts
<b>On Line Watch Link (OWL)</b>	Two way Neighbourhood Watch Communication System. Contains contact details for Co-ordinators & members
<b>ORIGIN Payroll System</b>	Forming part of the ORIGIN ERP System, the payroll system uses personal data to perform Gross to Net calculations, using HMRC, Pension and other regulations.
<b>Origin HR</b>	Central system for recording and updating human resource information and provides the source of personnel data to a range of other systems.
<b>Origin TAS</b>	Central system for recording and updating training and skills information.
<b>Origin HSR</b>	Central system for recording and updating Health and Safety information, including near miss, accident, assault, injury and incident recording.
<b>Origin DMS</b>	Central system for recording, updating and processing Duty Management information, including duty times, activities, overtime claims and authorisation. Linked to Origin Time Management process.
<b>Origin Payroll</b>	Central system for recording and updating salary information and to process the payroll run.
<b>Origin Procurement</b>	Central system for recording and updating purchase requests and authorisations relating to Staffordshire Police.
<b>Origin Finance</b>	Central system for recording and updating financial information relating to purchases and payments for the organisation.

<b>Origin BI Apps</b>	Data warehouse of information extracted from the HR, Payroll, Finance and Procurement modules of Origin, held for reporting purposes and automatically updated each day.
<b>Origin Org Charts</b>	Reporting tool used to display the organisational structure held with in the Origin HR system.
<b>Origin Self Service</b>	User interface for personal details held within the Origin HR and TAS system.
<b>Origin Portal Pages</b>	User interface for personal and team details held within the Origin HR and DMS system.
<b>Police National Computer (PNC)</b>	A national database which is electronically accessible 24 hours a day, and used extensively by law enforcement organisations across the UK, giving access to information of national and local significance.
<b>Police National Data base (PND)</b>	The Police National Database (PND) is a national information management system that improves the ability of the Police Service to manage and share intelligence and other operational information, to prevent and detect crime and make communities safer. The PND offers a capability for the Police Service to share, access and search local information electronically, overcoming artificial geographical and jurisdictional boundaries. PND holds data from 49 law enforcement agencies from forces crime recording, custody, intelligence, child protection and domestic violence. Information comes to the PND from 230 systems nationally and is accessible by specially trained and vetted staff. The system was initially set up following a recommendation from the Bichard Inquiry primarily for safeguarding.
<b>Police Works Drink Drive - previously known as LIBIS</b>	The asset enables the electronic filling in of the MGDD Drink Drive Forms. Information is pulled out of the NSPIS Custody System with the breath test results being pulled from the Lion 6000 Intoxilyzer Evidential Drink/Drive machine.
<b>Prisoner Intelligence Notification System (PINS)</b>	This is a Regional system owned by the region having been purchased and licenced by all four forces. The system provides access to prison data supplied by the HMPS of all current persons held in prisons in England and Wales.
<b>The PVP Disclosure Tracking System</b>	An inhouse nominal database that records requests for disclosure received within both the Protecting Vulnerable Adults (PVP) Disclosure Unit and the Partnership Information Exchange Team (PIET).
<b>Scan file (firearms)</b>	Electronic scanning system for all NFLMS holders
<b>Socrates</b>	Crime Scene Management administrative system.
<b>Solcara Spotlight Press Bureau Media Management System</b>	The system is a database which is used to record contact with the media including enquiries, responses and operational planning
<b>Source Management (Force and SB)</b>	Management of Covert Human Intelligence Source records and authorisations
<b>SPIN this is the Staffordshire Police Intelligence System.</b>	SPIN is the force networked Intelligence system which has been in use since 1996. All intelligence records are entered onto the system, evaluated for a policing purpose in line with MoPI guidelines and used to record, evaluate, analyse, manage and disseminate intelligence material.

<b>Staffordshire Police Survey data</b>	Victim and witness satisfaction data to inform government quality of service and force performance monitoring
<b>Staffordshire Police Citizens' and Staff Panel data</b>	Details of over 4000 citizens and staff who provide a valid representation of staff and public opinion to inform the development of policing in Staffordshire
<b>STORM Command and Control System</b>	Recording system of incidents reported to Staffordshire Police, including details of persons reporting incidents and subsequent deployment and finalisation information.
<b>Subject Access Request Management System</b>	To provide a central point for recording and tracking subject access requests
<b>Vehicle Recovery ( IT Programme called ELVIS VR)</b>	Electronic, web based, application to manage the movement of vehicles retained under police powers. It interfaces with STORM IT systems, and has limited access use via the internet to external garages.
<b>Vetting Database</b>	repository for the management of vetting requests, clearances and management information
<b>Video Identification Parade Electronic Recording (VIPER)</b>	This is an asset owned and maintained by West Yorkshire Police, which consists of a database of images of volunteers and PACE suspects used for the building of Video Identification Parades.
<b>Video Witness</b>	Custody still image capture facility and database
<b>ViSOR</b>	Management of Sexual and Violent Offenders
<b>VP/FPO and NES</b>	The system supports the administration of fixed penalty notices
<b>Warrant Management System</b>	Central database for recording electronic transfer of information from Staffordshire Crown and Magistrates Courts of all Fail To Appear warrants issued within the county of Staffordshire
