Policy owned by Investigative Services**STRAP****1. Policy Purpose and key drivers**

The STRAP Policy and its procedures apply to every person entering the STRAP environment for whatever reason. Access will only be granted based on a clear business need whilst necessary.

The security measures must be used as detailed.

The Non-STRAP Electronic Device (N-SED) applies to every person entering the STRAP Accredited Environment (SAE) for whatever reason.

The term N-SED covers all portable electronic devices with any connectivity, geolocation or data capture/storage capabilities.

- No personal N-SED should ever be brought into any part of the SAE.
- In exceptional circumstances where their presence is necessary for the job at hand, Police-issued devices (and those from specific partner agencies) can be temporarily brought into the SAE. This should be recorded in the official log book with a clearly defined business need.
- A business need includes duty of care, risk to life and current on-call status. For clarity, please ask the Head of Special Branch (HSB) or in their absence the STRAP Security Officer (STRAPSO) / Deputy STRAPSO.
- This is intended to be an exception to the rule and not normal business behaviour.
- The N-SED should be kept in the SAE for the minimum amount of time necessary. For example, as soon as the risk to life is resolved the N-SED should be removed from the SAE.
