Progress Report on the Review of Injury Pensioners

- The Force's review of injury pensioners began on 26 April 2017. So far, reviews have commenced for 20 people. By law a review cannot result in an injury pensioner being reduced to less than Band 1 or increased to more than Band 4.
- **The outcome of the completed reviews so far are as follows:**

No change due to there being no substantial alteration:

Band 1 – 4 people.

Band 2 – 1 person.

Band 3 – None yet completed.

Band 4 – 1 person.

Changed due to there being a substantial alteration:

Band 2 reduced to Band 1 – 1 person.

Band 3 reduced to Band 1 – 1 person.

Number of appeals lodged against the Selected Medical Practitioner's Report: None.

Reviews currently under way are as follows:

Band 1 – 2 people.

Band 2 – 4 people.

Band 3 – 5 people.

Band 4 – 1 person.

New Injury Pensioners - In the last 12 months, the numbers of new injury pensioners are as follows:

Band 1: 5 people; Band 2: none; Band 3: none; Band 4: 1 person.

Cases currently being assessed: 3.

Number of appeals ongoing: None.
