



Report to the Police Pensions Board – 26 October 2018

Third Progress Report on the Reviews of Injury Pensioners

The Force's reviews of injury pensioners began on 26 April 2017. So far, reviews have commenced for 53 people. By law a review cannot result in an injury pensioner being reduced to less than Band 1 or increased to more than Band 4. The outcomes of the completed reviews so far are as follows:

No change due to there being no substantial alteration:

Band 1 – 13 people

Band 2 – 4 people

Band 3 – 2 people

Band 4 – 2 people

Changed by the Determination of the Police Pension Authority due to there being a substantial alteration:

Band 2 reduced to Band 1 – 2 people

Band 3 reduced to Band 1 – 2 people

Awaiting the Determination of the Police Pension Authority under Regulation 33:

Band 2 – 7 people

Band 3 – 8 people

Band 4 – 2 people

Number of appeals ongoing against the Selected Medical Practitioner's report: 3
